KC's Own Queen of Haunts joins TV25 to Host Classic Horror Movie Programming Returning to Kansas City in October

Kansas City, MO (September 30, 2015) It is eerily fitting that TV25 selected Amber Arnett-Bequeaith to host the fun return of local late night spook shows to Kansas City in October. Arnett-Bequeaith has been involved with haunted houses since she was a child sleeping in a coffin prop for the family's haunted house business, and now the Queen of Haunts directs the world-class haunted houses in Kansas City's historic West Bottoms 12th Street Bridge District as well as serving as the Vice President of America's Haunts, an association of the top 30 haunted houses in the country.

The series titled *Macabre Cinema* gets its name from one of the West Bottoms' attractions that features a 1930's haunted theater. Horror hosts have a long and hallowed tradition on local TV, especially in Kansas City where the genre ran for many years.

The series will be filmed on location in the West Bottom's haunted houses, during its upcoming Scaring Season. *Macabre Cinema* features Arnett-Bequeaith's character Ambrosia-Queen of Haunts airing on Friday and Saturday nights on over the air TV channel 25.9 at 10pm.



A vintage horror classic will be featured each week with the host providing interesting information pertaining to the movie as well as "fright insight" into the longest, continuous operation of the West Bottoms haunted houses: Macabre Cinema, The Beast and Edge of Hell.

According to Brian Short, the series producer, "Amber has all the haunt history plus the charisma that connects with viewers. We are so excited to cast her in this role from her very own haunted living room. As the series progresses into the holiday season, we'll also branch out into the surrounding

neighborhood to discover the West Bottoms goes well beyond fright."



Viewers are also in for a treat with a chance to play along online or on their mobile devices to win a pair of Full Moon Festival passes, a \$170 value, good for entry into the Full Moon Productions community of haunted houses: Edge of Hell, Macabre Cinema and The Beast Haunted attractions this 2015 season and entry into the Beast Jump, and Macabre Bat Pole extreme options within the haunted houses.

TV25 is a free over the air TV service that does not require cable or satellite. Kansas City and Topeka viewers can access the station via an over the air antenna (available at big box stores like Walmart and Target). Viewers typically need to rescan their television to receive the free programming once connecting the air antenna. Free television is attracting a following as both young and old are looking for ways to save or downsize their optional services, as well as viewers who like the additional free television options to their subscription TV services.
